Willkommen in Lindenfels - Welcome to Lindenfels

Lindenfels consists of the small town Lindenfels itself and the communities Eulsbach, Glattbach, Kolmbach, Schlierbach, Seidenbuch, Winkel and Winterkasten, that were incorporated into the municipality in 1972, but still appear like separate villages. It is situated in the Geo-Naturepark "Bergstraße-Odenwald", member in the network of UNESCO Geoparks, and belongs to the district Bergstraße. Lindenfels has a total of about 5,000 inhabitants.

Lindenfels is protected by mixed forests bordering the town to the north and east. This results in a very mild sub-mountainous climate. Here you may find a wide network of marked hiking trails, complete with shelter huts and benches. In the old town centre with historic buildings, half-timbered houses and old town gates you may find the Lindenfels Museum and the German Dragon Museum. From the castle, there is a great view over the Odenwald, the former hunting ground of the Nibelung heroes. The heated outdoor pool is situated between Lindenfels and Schlierbach, it can be easily reached on foot.
